Leisure, Space, and Change encourages presentations that examine the relationship of leisure to transformation, across the variety of spaces where leisure occurs. We are viewing transformation broadly, to include change that is related to personal self-discovery and growth, as well as relationships to broader community and social change. Examining leisure through the lens of space encourages us, as a research community, to bring our projects together in new and different ways. For example, what are people learning about leisure in the spaces that are the centreposts of leisure and recreation as we know it, such as parks, wild areas, or community centres? And, what of those who are examining leisure in spaces that are less often considered, such as in the more private, hidden, or closed off spaces like subcultural clubs, institutional settings, or self-constructed retreats? Our hope is that these three thematic elements, when brought together, will open up new possibilities for conceptual frameworks, academic positionings, and research relationships.

Symposium Format

ORCOL envisions the symposium as an opportunity to facilitate dialogue and foster connections among scholars in the leisure studies community. To that end, while abstracts will follow the standard peer-review process, the symposium is open to presentations that introduce new frameworks, pose critiques, or explore new topics. Session presentations will be organized around themes, and each session will have time allotted for discussion among presenters and participants.

Format for Submitting Proposals:

Interested authors should submit an abstract summary of their paper for presentation (maximum 500 words). Allow 1" (2.5 cm) margins and use at least 12 pt. type, preferably in Times New Roman. Citations should be provided in the text, although a reference list is not necessary. Please include a title page with full author contact information and affiliations. No author names should appear in the abstract.

All proposals must be received via email attachment by November 15, 2008
